## How do I convert an error code to text when FORMAT\_MESSAGE\_FROM\_SYSTEM doesn't work?

For the same reason that <u>not all error codes are defined in winerror.h</u>, not all error strings are defined in the system message table. If you've ever played with the message compiler, you'd quickly have recognized the <u>winerror.h</u> file as the header file associated with a message resource. In other words, there's a <u>.mc</u> file that gets processed by the message compiler, and out pops the message resource (which becomes the system message table) and the <u>winerror.h</u> header file.

As we saw a few years ago, <u>not all error messages live in winerror.h</u>, which means that not all error messages live in the system message table. Each component that provides error codes outside of <u>winerror.h</u> needs to provide its own message table. For example, <u>messages for network errors can be found in netmsg.dll</u>. Similarly, <u>winhttp error message text can be found in winhttp.dll</u>. I don't know about other message ranges; hopefully the documentation for the component that generates those errors also mentions where you can find the text.
