Why do I get the error REGDB_E_IIDNOTREG when I call a method that returns an interface?



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This is another manifestation of the <u>missing marshaller problem</u>.

```
IContextMenu *pcm;
HRESULT hr = psf->GetUIObjectOf(hwnd, 1, &pidl,
               IID_IContextMenu, NULL, &pcm);
// fails with REGDB_E_IIDNOTREG
```

The IContextMenu interface does not have a proxy/stub factory (as of this writing). Recall that shell objects, as a rule, are apartment model. If you create the object from a multithreaded apartment, COM needs to build a wrapper object which can marshal calls from offthread back onto the original thread, in order to adhere to the threading rules for apartmentmodel objects.

And if the COM standard marshaler can't find a proxy/stub factory for an interface, it returns the error REGDB E IIDNOTREG.

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
