alexx is looking for a <u>keyboard-only equivalent to the ctrl+click trick I mentioned a few days</u> <u>ago</u>.

- Ctrl+Shift+Esc: This opens Task Manager.
- From the Applications tab, use Ctrl+Space to select the two windows you want.
- Alt+W (open the *Windows* menu)
- V (Tile <u>V</u>ertically)

Not as quick, but it still works. And it works <u>even if the windows you want got converted into</u> <u>a group</u>.

Of course, on Windows 7, you can use the Win+Left and Win+Right hotkeys. (Users with multiple monitors can <u>couple this with Win+Shift+Left and Win+Shift+Right</u>.)
