I always forget how to do this, so I'm going to write it down so I can look it up later. When a video is playing, right-click the volume control slider and select *Enhancements*, then *Play speed settings*. (Actually, it also works if you right-click the speaker icon, the Stop button, the Replay button, or the Shuffle button, but the volume control slider is the biggest target.) On the *Play speed settings* dialog, the single-step controls are at the bottom; they look like triangles.
